The selection available is:

Unwooded Chardonnay 2007 Barossa

A bright golden wine with a crisp dry style providing a universal appeal. Pineapple, green apples, peach and a hint of guava, with a balance of acidity and fruit concentration gives a complex edge to this wine which is great with roast chicken, Thai green curry, salmon steaks and most fish dishes.

Merlot Cabernet 2003 Coonawarra

Intense dark red showing some aged signs in the glass, this wine has a rich and full bodied flavour with strong influences of ripe cherries, plums and hints of cassis and leather. The aroma evokes rich spices, dark cherries and chocolate with hints of fine French oak and caramel. Mouth filling tannins and a clean acidity drive a complex and rewarding finish to the palate. This wine is perfect with all tomato pasta dishes, spicy and roast lamb and most meat dishes. It should also be decanted for at least one hour before drinking.
