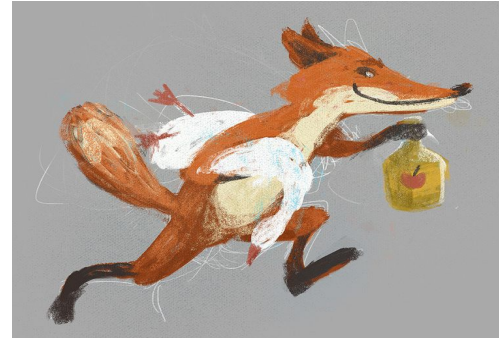

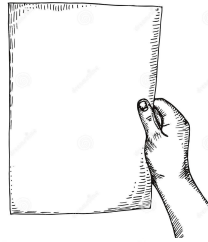

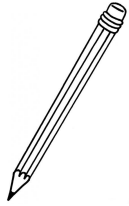

# WHAT ARE ILLUSTRATIONS?

**ILLUSTRATIONS** are pictures that help us tell a story.

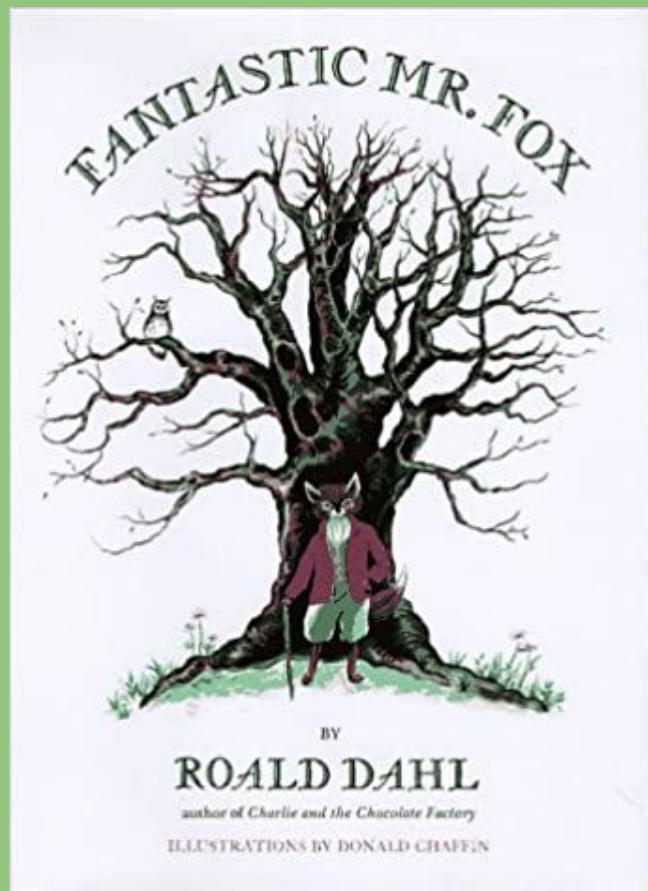
First a book is written by an **AUTHOR**.

Then the writing is given to an artist. These artists are called **ILLUSTRATORS**. It is their job to draw the pictures to go with the story.

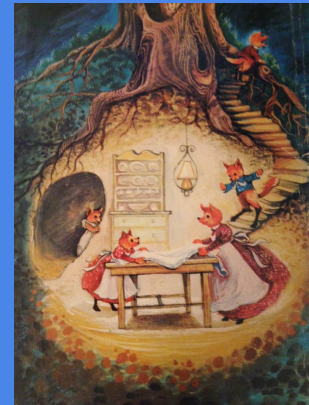
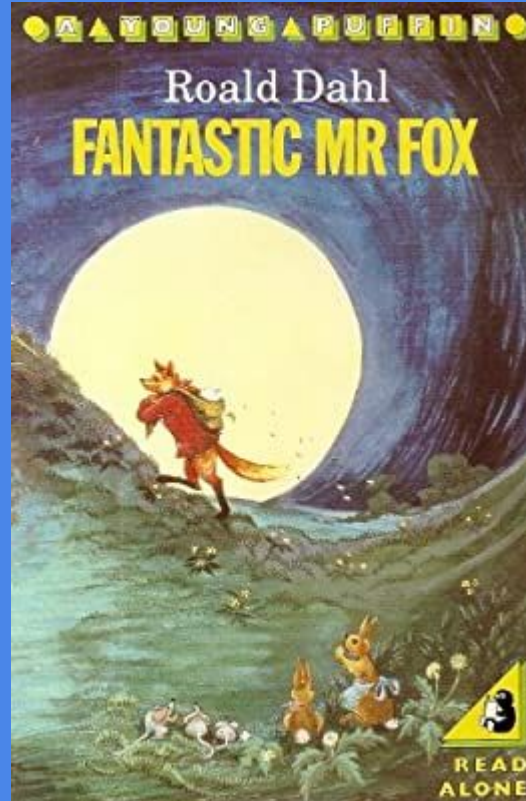
Fantastic Mr Fox has been illustrated by lots of different **ILLUSTRATORS**. On the next few slides are some examples.

the **AUTHOR** Roald Dahl.

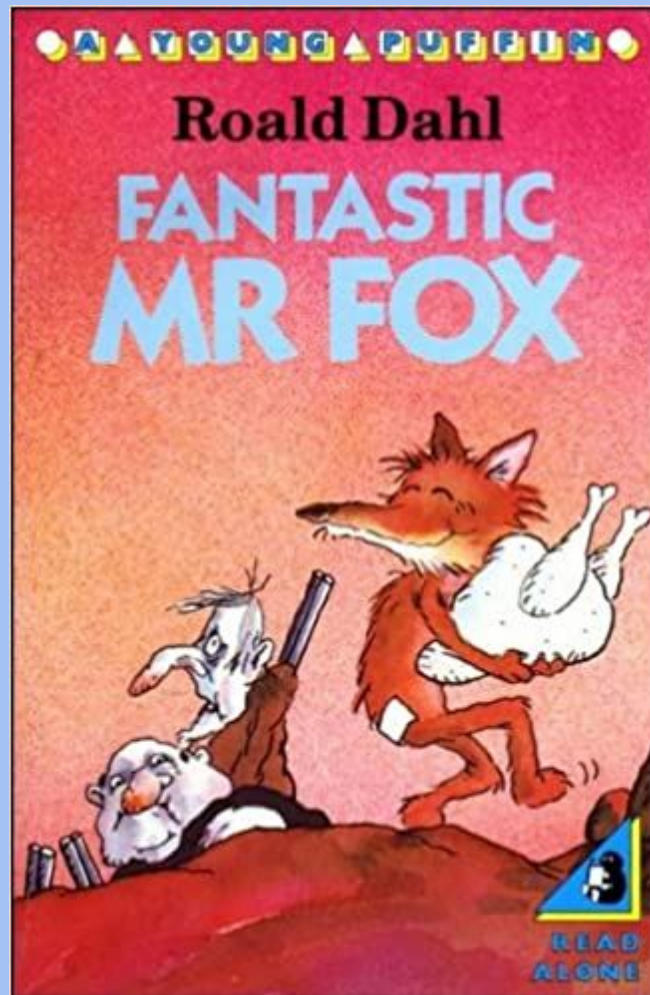

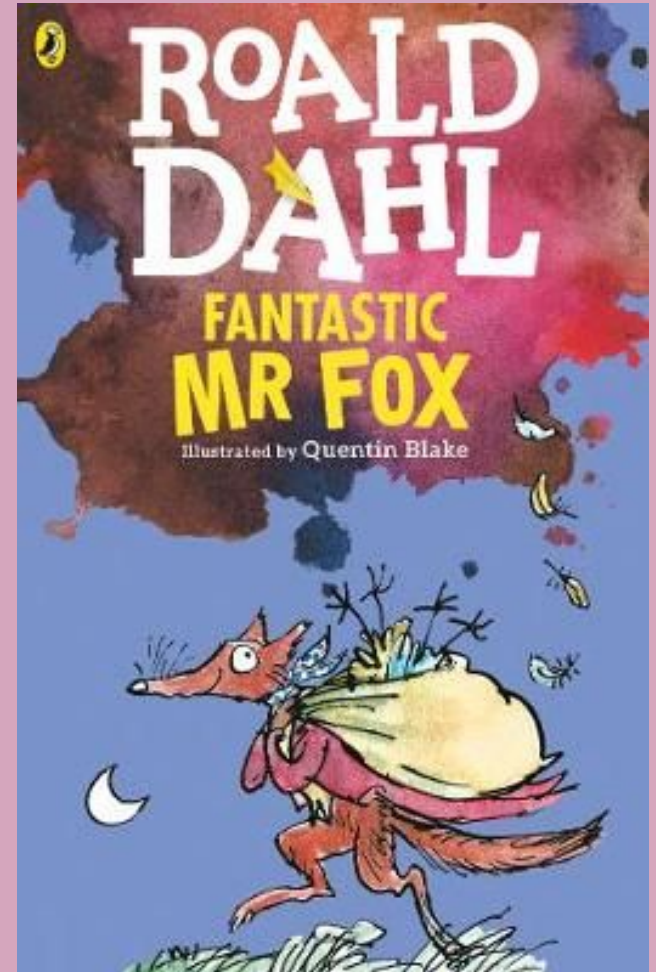

# DRAWING CHARACTERS

The first job of an illustrator is to understand the story they are drawing the pictures for.

Next work out how to draw the characters.

When drawing animal characters illustrators look at real animals for inspiration



Illustrators often make their animal characters look human. (Warning BIG word!)

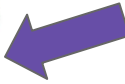

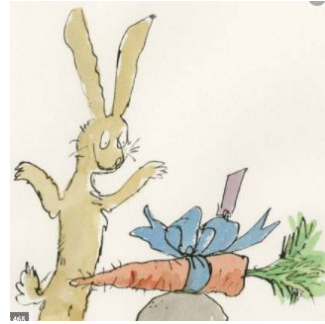

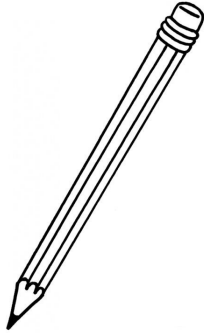
Look at the realistic animal or human.
