So now that you've had a go at ILLUSTRATING your own character from Fantastic Mr Fox.




We are going to turn these ILLUSTRATIONS into ILLUMINATED LETTERS.


TO DRAW YOUR OWN ILLUMINATED LETTER







WHAT ARE ILLUMINATED LETTERS?



In the Middle Ages, which was from 400AD to 1400AD all books were written by hand.



In the Middle Ages most books were religious so they were made by Monks and Nuns.



Books were copied LETTER by LETTER, WORD by WORD...this took a really really long time.

Here is a very famous example: **THE BOOK of KELLS**



The Book of Kells was made in 800AD.


It is thought to be **1,173** years old!!!

It is a very important historical object and is now kept in Trinity College Library Dublin.



Inside the Book of Kells there are hundreds of pictures called:

ILLUMINATIONS







ILLUMINATED LETTERS

At the start of a story there are often letters decorated with drawings. These are called **Illuminated Letters**

They are bigger than the rest of the letters and very colourful.




The letters were often painted with gold so they reflected light. This is why they are called Illuminations.

You are going to create your own illuminated letter based on the story of Fantastic Mr Fox.








STEP 1 :

You can use a ruler if you want.








STEP 2: ILLUSTRATING

Now you have your letter drawn out we need to decorate it to make it into an Illuminated Letter.

REMEMBER: Drawings that help us tell a story are called **Illustrations.**
