

Resolution submitted by: France

Concerning: The Human Rights Situation in the Occupied Palestinian Territory

The Human Rights Council

<i>Recognising</i>	the right of both the Israeli and Palestinian peoples to separate, independent states.
<i>Alarmed by the</i>	2000 Palestinian children killed since 2000.
<i>Noting with deep concern</i>	that there are over 9000 Palestinian deaths since 2000.
<i>Deeply disturbed by</i>	the recognition by the United States of America of Jerusalem as the capital of Israel.
<i>Having studied</i>	the complexity of the geopolitical situation in the Middle East.
<i>Deploring</i>	the terrorist activities of Hamas and affiliated groups.
<i>Further deploring</i>	the illegal actions of Israeli Zionist settlers in Palestine.

1. *Calls for*
 - i. The immediate recognition of the State of Palestine by the international community and UN, and the subsequent conferring of a seat for Palestine at the UN.
 - ii. Members of the UN to negotiate and reach a fair and equitable solution to the refugee problem.

2. *Demanding*
 - i. the return of borders to their 1967 lines, with any loss and gain of territory equivalent to these lines, in order to best ensure the security of both states, arbitrated by the UN.
 - ii. the recognition of Jerusalem as the equal capital of both Israel and the State of Palestine.

3. *Urging*
 - i. A meeting between government ministers from both Israel, the State of Palestine, as well as religious leaders, to discuss the prevention of violence between Palestinians and Israelis.
 - ii. Members of the UN to arrange security in order to preserve the sovereignty of the Palestinian State and guaranteeing the security of Israel.

4. *Requesting*

i. The UN to establish a Committee for the Security of Israel Palestine Relations (CSIPR) in order to protect the freedom of speech, worship and movement of Palestinian and Israeli citizens.

5. *Further urging*

i. Immediately declaring any settlement building or other infringements of the territorial sovereignty of either state as illegal.

ii. The monitoring of any illegal settlement building by either nation.

iii. The UN Security Council implement sanctions on either state ignoring Clause 5.

6. *Requiring*

iii. Clauses 1, 2 and 3 to be fully implemented by December of 2022.
